Essential

- 1. Qualified to practice as a solicitor in NSW and holds or is eligible to hold a current practising certificate and at least 2 years post-admission experience.
- 2. Demonstrated ability to take initiative, accept responsibility, and work with limited supervision providing advice and conducting casework on a range of issues.
- 3. Demonstrated ability to communicate and negotiate effectively with clients and relevant government and community organisations.
- 4. Demonstrated ability to work with disadvantaged and vulnerable clients, including Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and people from non-English speaking backgrounds.
- 5. Commitment to the objectives of Community Legal Centres.
- Demonstrated ability to conduct community legal education, policy and law reform work including identifying systemic issues and drafting policy and law reform submissions.
- 7. Understanding of and ability to implement access and equity principles.

Desirable

- 8. Experience conducting test cases, community legal education, media and/or campaigns and activities aimed at achieving law reform.
- 9. Experience in discrimination law.
