Selection Criteria

Essential

1. Qualified to practice as a solicitor in NSW and holds or is eligible to hold a current practising certificate and at least 2 years post-admission experience.
2. Commitment to the objectives of Community Legal Centres.
3. Demonstrated ability to take initiative, accept responsibility, and work with limited supervision providing advice and conducting casework on a range of civil legal issues.
4. Demonstrated ability to work with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander clients and organisations,
5. Capacity to work with stakeholders to develop and manage new legal services in a health justice context.

Desirable

6. Demonstrated ability to undertake policy and law reform work including identifying systemic issues and drafting submissions to government and other relevant decision makers.
7. Experience in child protection early intervention matters.
8. Experience in conducting community education, media and/or law reform campaigns.
