Essential

- 1. Qualified to practice as a solicitor in NSW and holds or is eligible to hold a current practising certificate and at least 2 years post-admission experience.
- 2. Commitment to the objectives of Community Legal Centres.
- Demonstrated ability to take initiative, accept responsibility, and work with limited supervision providing advice and conducting casework on a range of civil legal issues.
- 4. Demonstrated ability to work with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander clients and organisations,
- 5. Capacity to work with stakeholders to develop and manage new legal services in a health justice context.

Desirable

- 6. Demonstrated ability to undertake policy and law reform work including identifying systemic issues and drafting submissions to government and other relevant decision makers.
- 7. Experience in child protection early intervention matters.
- 8. Experience in conducting community education, media and/or law reform campaigns.
