Selection Criteria**

Essential

1. Qualified to practice as a solicitor in NSW and holds or is eligible to hold a practising certificate and at least 2 years post-admission experience.
2. Commitment to the objectives of Community Legal Centres.
3. Demonstrated ability to take initiative, accept responsibility, and work with limited supervision providing advice and conducting casework on a range of civil legal issues.
4. Demonstrated ability to provide legal services to people experiencing vulnerability and to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander clients.
5. Excellent interpersonal skills, including experience in or demonstrated ability to develop strong partnerships with health professionals, community organisations and government agencies.

Desirable

6. Demonstrated ability to undertake policy and law reform work including identifying systemic issues and drafting submissions to government and other relevant decision makers.
7. Experience in delivering community legal education.
